India



Launched in 2023, Sponsor A Child India is dedicated to rescuing vulnerable children from underprivileged neighborhoods who are at high risk of human trafficking and exploitation. We believe every child deserves safety, education, and the opportunity to build a brighter future.

Through a rehabilitation-based approach, we provide a safe haven where children receive daily nutritious meals and foundational education, including reading and writing. To further support their learning journey, we distribute school supplies in March and backpacks in August, equipping them with essential tools for growth.

World Harvest expanded its facilities in Mumbai and introduced a group of electric rickshaws (Bajaj) to promote eco-friendly and sustainable transportation. This initiative not only helps reduce carbon emissions but also provides more affordable transport and economic opportunities for the local community.

Income from this program will be directed toward supporting educational facilities and community development, aligning with our vision to improve livelihoods, encourage entrepreneurship, and create a more sustainable future for communities in India.

Nepal

On September 26, massive flooding struck Kathmandu, Nepal, destroying thousands of homes and leaving many families displaced and without belongings. In response to this emergency, World Harvest took immediate action to provide essential aid. We assisted over 400 affected individuals by supplying food, clean water, first aid services, and blankets, while also supporting them in rebuilding their homes and restoring their lives.



Uganda



During our visit to Kampala, we had the privilege of meeting sponsored children in person and seeing firsthand the impact of World Harvest's programs on their lives. We listened to their stories, learned about their hobbies and dreams, and encouraged them to believe in their potential and a better future.

Engaging in these activities not only provided valuable learning experiences but also facilitated the development of essential skills, bolstered self confidence, and opened new avenues for their future. Participation in extracurricular activities has been linked to higher academic performance and enhanced personal growth.



Pakistan



After receiving a donated building in the heart of Karachi, we immediately launched a renovation project to transform it into a school. With improved facilities and furnishings, the school officially opened in September 2023, offering quality education to local children. Beyond academics, it also promotes equal learning opportunities for all genders, especially girls, empowering them to build a brighter future. More than just a place of learning, the school stands as a symbol of hope for families dedicated to creating a brighter future for their children.



In March 2024, SAC Quetta officially opened, just one month after the completion of major school renovations. In a short time, 70 children have enrolled, and this number is expected to continue growing. The school's existence stand as a testament to how education creates opportunities and transforms the future for children and families in the community.

Siera Leone



At Canyon Hills, our community has completed new facility projects and is now working to secure clean water for 50 families. Although a deep well has been built, a drilling machine is still needed to break through granite layers and ensure better water availability. With support from World Harvest, we remain committed to fulfill this essential need and improve quality of life.



Additionally, in August 2024, we hosted Kids Camping, a residential program for 100 children, where they explored their artistic talents and gained valuable insights into gender equality, technology, and entrepreneurship. This experience not only cultivated their creativity spirit but also bolstered their confidence and instilled a renewed sense of optimism for the future.



Türkiye

On February 6, 2023, a devastating earthquake struck Türkiye and Syria, marking one of the deadliest tragedies in nearly 20 years. More than 51,000 lives were lost, millions were displaced, and over 7 million children were affected.

In response, World Harvest acted swiftly and became one of the first humanitarian organizations on the ground, arriving just two days after the catastrophe. Our team worked tirelessly in Adiyaman Province and nearby cities including Antalya, Malatya, Kahramanmaras, and Celesta, providing winter tents, blankets, and warm clothing to protect survivors, especially children, from the bitter cold.



King's Day in *Vreeland*

Each year on April 27th, World Harvest Europe hosts a fundraising event in Vreeland to celebrate the Dutch King's Birthday, providing an opportunity to connect with the community and support humanitarian missions. As in previous years, World Harvest Europe set up a food stand featuring a variety of dishes made from well-known Harvest products. This year, all proceeds from the event were dedicated to supporting Sekolah Wahana Harapan in Kedaung, Tangerang, facilitating access to quality education for more children and providing them with a brighter future.



History *Festival*

As part of its dedication to assisting communities in need, World Harvest Europe engages in various humanitarian initiatives to contribute to a brighter future for Indonesia. Alongside hosting a booth at the History Festival, World Harvest Europe also joined a food bazaar, serving satay and an assortment of bread. Proceeds from these sales directly support the foundation's humanitarian programs.

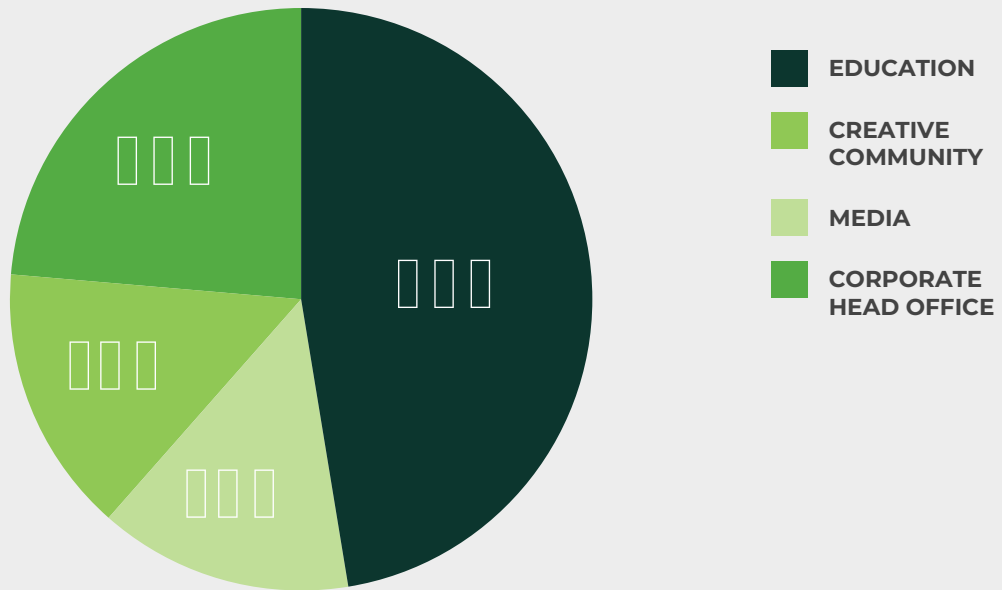


Christmas *Bazaar*

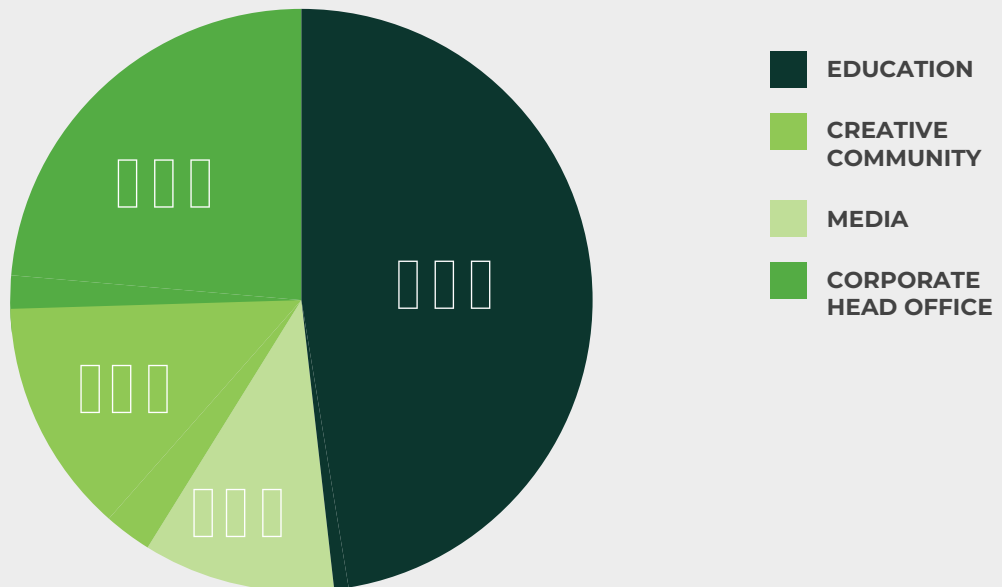
